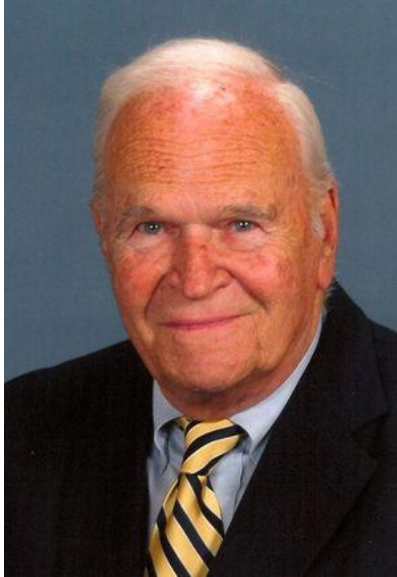


Jack Dye Scholarship Fund
