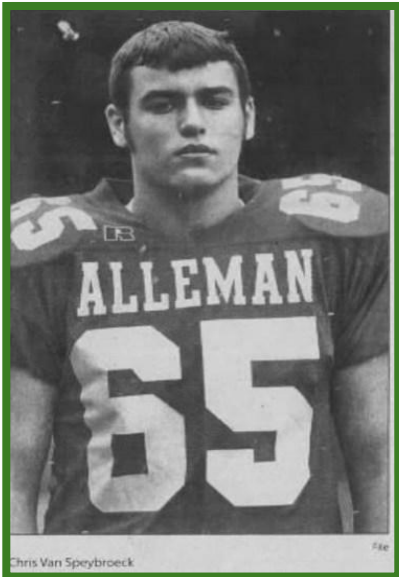


VanSpeybroeck Family Scholarship
